ABOUT THE CAMPS

Little Hitters Camp - \$30

Friday, December 27 10:00 am - Noon This camp is for "Little Hitters" ages 3-8. This camp will include instruction on general baseball skills for young players.

Holiday Hitting Camp - \$30

Friday, December 27 1:00 – 3:00 pm This hitting clinic is designed for those players who want to improve their overall hitting fundamentals. We will have a limit of 36 players/camp.

Baseball Skills Camp - \$30

Saturday, December 28 10:00 am - Noon This camp is designed for players in grades 2-8 and will include instruction on the general skills of infield play, outfield play, base running and more.


Pitching/Catching Camp - \$30

CAMP DIRECTOR

Derek Woodley will be in his 13th season at the helm of the Yellow Jacket baseball program and is 2nd winningest coach in the history of the program. During that time, Defiance has eight of the top win totals in the program's history.

In his first 12 years with the Yellow Jackets, Woodley has seen 63 DC players named to the All-Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference Team, while also placing 26 studentathletes on the HCAC All-Academic squad.

In 2019, Woodley guided the Yellow Jackets to the programs second-most wins in school history and led Defiance to an HCAC Tournament berth, the first since the 2013 season. Woodley was recognized by the HCAC for the accomplishments of the 2019 season as he was selected HCAC Co-Coach of the Year for the second time (2013).

Woodley has 25 years of coaching experience at the collegiate level and served as the assistant coach at Manchester University prior to accepting his current position at DC.

During his stint at Manchester, Woodley helped guide the Spartans to a pair of appearances in the HCAC Tournament in 2006 and 2007 in addition to earning a berth in the Mideast Regional in 2006.

Prior to coaching at MU, Woodley spent 12 seasons at Bethany Lutheran College in Minnesota where he accumulated a 141-90 record, while winning three league titles, a pair of regional championships and two NJCAA Region XIII Coach-of-the-Year honors during a six-year stint as the Vikings' head coach. Woodley was also an assistant at Bethany Lutheran for six seasons before taking over the reins of the program and saw the team win four league titles and three regional crowns during that time.

Woodley worked as a part-time scout for the St. Louis Cardinals from 2000-2004 and served as a coach in the Northwoods League for the Mankato Mashers and Mankato Moondogs from 2000-2003.

Other camp staff will include current Defiance College baseball coaches and players.
